In the near future, Pharmacies will be able to obtain prescriptions electronically without the need for a paper copy. The Government's National programme for electronic transfer of prescriptions (ETP) is in the process of rolling out throughout the UK. You will be asked to nominate just ONE pharmacy for all your prescription needs so that your doctor's surgery can send them to your selected choice of pharmacy. We hope that you will choose us to receive and dispense your prescriptions. This form is designed to allow you to authorise us to both collect your current paper prescription at present and to nominate us to receive future electronic prescriptions. A separate leaflet published by Connecting for Health (The information technology division of the NHS) explaining full details about ETP is available from this pharmacy.

Follow these simple steps

- 1** Print out this form, sign it and return to the pharmacy by post or hand it to a member of staff when you're next in.
- 2** Let us have a recent copy of the white paper half of your prescription(s).
- 3** Next time you require a prescription, simply order through our website or telephone us with details of the medicines you require.
- 4** Allow up to 3 days for the prescription to be collected and processed by us.
- 5** We'll deliver your medicines to you for free or you can come and collect in store.
